DOWNTOWN SYCAMORE CHALK WALK GUIDLINES & RULES

ARTISTS

- Only registered artists may participate. Payment must accompany registration.
- All artists must read, agree to and sign an Artists Disclaimer & Waiver to participate.
- Art square spaces will be assigned at registration by Sycamore Chamber Staff
- Artists should be finished by 3 pm on Saturday for Judging.
- Artists must be 12 years or older (unless participating as a family/team)

CHALK

- ONE 24 box of Pastel Chalk will be provided for Adult, Youth & Family/Team Artists registered.
- If you need additional colors, you may share or exchange chalk with other artists.
- You may also purchase or use your own chalk but it MUST be water-based.
- We ask that you return unused chalk to the Artist Check-in.

ART & ARTIST RULES

- Chalk art is only to be produced in designated and assigned 5X5 area.
- The art created must be suitable for public and family viewing (no nude or lewd work).
- No words, symbols, or caricatures intended as political statements may appear within the art.
- Art created must be culturally sensitive and appropriate, respecting the diversity promoted in our event.
- Chalk art depicting or intended as an advertisement for a business, product, or service is not allowed.
- No banners, products, samples, or promotional brochures are allowed. Artists may hand out business cards.
- Sycamore Chamber reserves the right to refuse, stop or eliminate objectionable art or art not consistent with rules.
- Please try to keep your supplies to a minimum and well contained in your space.
- No bluetooth speakers are allowed. You may wear portable headsets.
- No pets, please!
- Your chalk art must only include chalk. Any non chalk props or items used in the artwork are prohibited.
- Downtown Sycamore Chalk Walk is a TOBACCO FREE Event.
- By participating, you consent to photography and video recording to be used for news, promotional purposes, advertising, inclusion on websites, social media, or any other purpose by the Sycamore Chamber of Commerce and its affiliates and representatives.



ARTISTS TIPS

If reproducing an image originally created by another artist (living or deceased), it is important to credit the original artist and the title at the base of your painting.
